RULES FOR CHILI COMPETITION

1. Registration must be sent in by February 16, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.
2. You can enter more than 1 chili. Entry fee is \$25.00 for 1 entry, \$15.00 for each additional chili.
3. Chili must be prepared in advance.
4. Set up begins at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, February 24th.
5. Teams are responsible for supplying a source of heat to keep chili warm - camp stove, generator, etc. They are also responsible for serving utensils. There are a limited number of electric outlets available on a first come basis.
6. We will provide sampling cups, spoons, bowls and napkins.
7. Each team must provide a minimum of 6 quarts of chili.
8. Chili must be ready to judge by 11:30 a.m. After judges sample, chili will be open to public sampling and judging. "Peoples Choice" voting will be closed at 1:00p.m.

JUDGING OF CHILI

1. A total of three judges will judge entries for the following on a scale of 1 to 10:
 - ◆ Color
 - ◆ Aroma
 - ◆ Consistency
 - ◆ Taste
 - ◆ After-taste
2. Judging will be on score cards, which are numbered. Each team will be assigned a number upon check-in.
3. There will be two trophies awarded "Judges Best Chili" and "Peoples Choice."
4. In the event of a tied score, judges will re-taste and cast a tie-breaker vote. The decision of the judges is final.
5. Chili will be judged by judges at 11:30 a.m. after that chili will be open for attendees to taste and vote for the peoples choice. Voting will close at 1:00 p.m.
6. Awards will be presented with the Polar Plunge Awards.



TASTING OF CHILI

1. Attendees will be admitted for tasting when judges have finished.
2. Cost to sample all entries is \$5.00 for a 2 ounce sample of each chili, a corn muffin and a bottle of water.
3. After tasting attendees will vote for their favorite chili by number, voting will be closed at 1:00 p.m.
